It was a very thorough, intense and rewarding experience and we are both pleased with the outcome as well as with the understanding and professional nature that the inspector conducted the inspection. The school that we all know shone through with the children representing themselves, us and you with great confidence, ability, and humour—they were real stars. Our foundations of strong pupil outcomes, inclusive adaptations, high expectations for behaviour, a safe space to grow, and a kind school community, were clearly evident and observed by the inspector and we are so pleased that these key themes were at the forefront of the feedback we received. We have one target for improvement which is for us to ensure that in a small number of subjects, we embed the high levels of quality seen in the rest of the curriculum. This work has already begun and we have a plan that will help us achieve this. We are awaiting the draft for the report itself and once this has been agreed with Ofsted, I will be able to share the report and outcomes with you all in more detail.
