



SEND and Inclusion:

Inclusion is a central part of the ethos and values at Barnham Primary School.

We support a large number of children with SEND and additional needs both through our mainstream provision and through our Special Support Centre (SSC) called The Orchard.

The Orchard SSC

The Orchard caters for up to 12 children with an EHCP who have Physical Disabilities and/or Speech and Language Difficulties.

All children are taught primarily within a mainstream classroom but have access to our physiotherapy room, changing places toilet and intervention rooms, alongside our trained and experienced staff, to maximise their development both academically, physically and with their communication skills. Children attending The Orchard have enhanced contact with Physiotherapists, Occupational Therapists and Speech and Language Therapists, depending on the provision stated in their EHCP.
