School Clubs – Spring Term 2021

We are pleased to let you know that, from January, we will be offering a limited selection of after school activity clubs for children from Yr R through to 6. All clubs will be run by Premier Sports. Their staff hold a variety of sporting qualifications and safeguarding certificates including an enhanced DBS check and First Aid qualifications. Clubs will start during the week commencing 11th January and end in the week commencing 22nd March 2021.

Each club will run for specific year groups on set days and will ensure that bubbles do not mix. There will be a maximum number of 20 children per club and places will be available on a **first come, first served basis**.

Archery:

Tuesday 3:30-4:15pm, 12th Jan – 23rd March (10 weeks), (£44.99) Years 5 and 6 only

Wednesday 3:30-4:15pm, 13th Jan – 24th March (10 weeks), (£44.99) Years 3 and 4 only

This 'mini' version of archery has child-friendly equipment and is called Arrows. The sessions include lots of activities and competitions. The activities enable us to use archery as a way of encouraging learning in other areas; for example, maths through scoring. These activities provide an alternative and complementary way of developing movement skills (such as coordination, balance, and strength), and personal, social and mental skills, as well as archery skills.
