

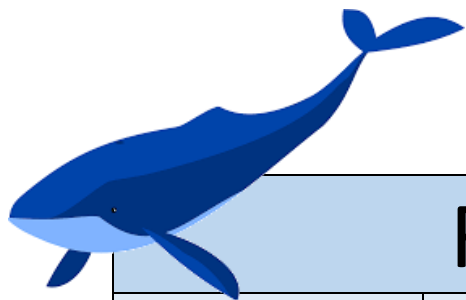
Oceans of the world

Finding out about the world's major oceans.

Outcome: a detailed knowledge of the world's 5 oceans and some of the creatures that inhabit them.

Key vocabulary	Definition
Ocean	A continuous body of salt water that cover approximately 70% of the earth's surface.
Sea	A large, partially enclosed body of salt water, smaller than an ocean.
Coast	Area of land bordering the sea, can feature sand, mud, cliffs or beaches.
Continent	A large, continuous landmass (one of 7 in the world, often containing different countries).
World	Refers to Earth, the planet where we live, the only planet known to sustain life.





Foundation Subjects Overview

<p>Science – Summer 1 Plants</p> <p>The children will be finding out about, naming and identifying a range of plants and flowers. They will be learning about the parts of flowers and plants as well as investigating the life-cycle of a plant and how it reproduces. They will learn overarm and underarm skills as they work towards playing a ball-based team game.</p>	<p>Music – FOUNDATION WEEK Singing: on this island</p> <p>Through this unit, the children learn folk songs and create sounds to represent three contrasting landscapes; seaside, countryside and city.</p>	<p>Art – FOUNDATION WEEK Drawing</p> <p>In this unit, children will learn about drawing skills, such as observation, sketching and adding texture and shade to create a visually appealing piece,</p>
<p>Science – Summer 2 The Seasons</p> <p>Building on previous work, the children in key stage 1 will learn about the 4 seasons and cycles of growing, decay, warming and cooling during the year.</p>	<p>RE – Summer 2 Ceremonies</p> <p>Through this topic, the children will find out about what a ceremony is and learn about ceremonies from different religions, comparing what is the same and contrasting with what is different.</p>	<p>Geography – Summer 2 Human themes</p> <p>Through this unit, the children will find out about the oceans, seas and coastlines of the UK. They will learn about how humans impact the coast and what we can do to protect our island.</p>	<p>PE – Summer 2 Run, Jump & Throw</p> <p>During this unit of work, the children will begin to link the skills of running and jumping as the work towards putting together some simple athletic skills.</p>	<p>Computing – FOUNDATION WEEK Data Handling</p> <p>Through this unit, children will find out about collecting and presenting data. They will use information to build pictograms and graphs using their computer skills.</p>	<p>DT – FOUNDATION WEEK Simple stiches</p> <p>During this unit, children will learn to join fabrics to create a simple outcome.</p>
